with children in Year 3 supporting their Science topic of 'Forces'. Izzie told us that



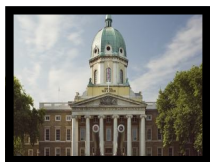
"we learned

School Meals at Deansfield: Please remember to pay for school meals in advance at a cost of £7.00 per week (£1.40 per day) for children in Year 3 and above. Please ensure that you pay on a regular basis so that a debt does not accrue.

Please also remember that from 1 April 2016, our catering provide, GS Plus, is putting the cost of school meals up to £1.60 per day, making this £8 per week. This is the first rise in ten year and goes some way to meeting the additional rises in the London Living Wage for Catering staff together with other cost rises.

If you are paying your school meals on AGORA you will need to remember to take this increase into account when making payments past 1 April. Many thanks
